Looking to fund a cool new program or community service? If you represent a nonprofit organization serving individuals in MEC's service territory, you might qualify for a BVC grant.

The next deadline for consideration is Wednesday, Aug. 31. Applications are accepted on a rolling timeline and are reviewed three times per calendar year:

April 30 | Aug. 31 | Dec. 31

TO QUALIFY

- A 501(c)(3) registered nonprofit, as defined in the Internal Revenue Code
- A recognized government entity at the state, county, or city level, including law enforcement or fire departments, requesting funds exclusively for public purposes
- A nonprofit holding a tax-exempt status as a public charity benefiting veterans, as specified under Section 501(c)(19) of the Internal Revenue Code
- In some cases, a nonprofit holding another IRS designation, such as 501(c)(4) or 501(c)(7), if the organization benefits the public at large
