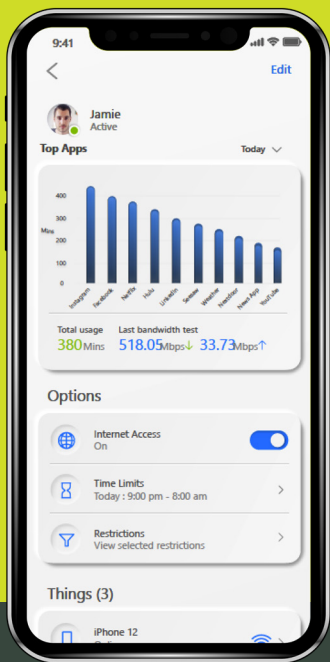

MEC is governed by a nine-member board of directors who represent customers living in their districts. In 2022, Districts 6, 7, and 9 were up for election for three-year terms. All three board members representing those districts ran unopposed for reelection. Ben Russell, of Constantine, represents District 6 in MEC's service territory. Gerry Bundle, of Cassopolis, represents District 7, while Dan Bodette, of Wauseon, Ohio, represents District 9.

In 2023, Districts 1, 2 and 5 will be up for election. District 1 is represented by Fred Turk of Decatur. District 2 is represented by Jim Dickerson of Bloomington, and District 5 is represented by John Green of Dowagiac. Manage Your Family's Internet Use

Frustrated with trying to manage when and how your kids use the internet? Our free CommandIQ app helps you take control. If you're an MEC Wi-Fi customer, you have access to a range of parental controls so you can limit their time online, restrict certain apps and content, or prioritize your devices over theirs to ensure you've always got the best connection.

First, create profiles for all your family members. For each person, add their devices to their profile. Now when you click on a profile, you'll see that person's usage statistics, including how many minutes they've spent online and which apps they've used.

Restrictions will allow you to set content filters and block subjects like gambling, violence, or even individual apps and websites. Time Limits lets you specify hours during which Wi-Fi will be inaccessible.
